Marjorie Jane "Sister" Miller gained her angel wings February 29, following a brief illness. She was 79.

Born December 23, 1944, to Oscar and Jane Miller, Sister was a sweet and thoughtful spirit who never met a stranger. She was a wonderful storyteller and a fierce lover of animals, having cared for pets from RikRak the raccoon to Elmo the owl, and a long list of very lucky cats and dogs, including many strays. Sister was an excellent cook. She loved a good laugh and a harmless prank - you never knew what to expect when opening a letter or package from her.

A 1963 graduate of Albany High School, Sister attended Wesleyan College in Macon, where she broke some rules in the name of fun, including rolling up her pants so she'd appear to be wearing a dress beneath her coat as young Wesleyan ladies were not supposed to wear pants in public. She was often seen during those years zipping around Macon on the back of her brother's motorcycle, the two of them dedicated to one another all their lives, right up to her final moments.
